Dear Sir,

Please recall our earlier communications regarding pre-arrival COVID-19 testing of international travellers to India from identified high-risk countries to minimize the risk of importation of variants of SARS-CoV-2 virus.

- 2. In the context of the evolving trajectory of COVID-19 cases in some countries especially China, Singapore, Hong Kong, Republic of Korea, Thailand and Japan and reports regarding circulation of variants of SARS-CoV-2 in these countries, it has been decided that the existing guidelines for international arrivals needs to be revised and updated.
- As per the revised guidelines, a mandatory requirement for pre-departure RT-PCR testing (to be conducted within 72 hrs prior to undertaking the journey) has been introduced for passengers in all international flights from these countries (mentioned in para 2 above).
- This will also apply to transiting passengers through the countries (mentioned in para 2) irrespective of their originating countries before coming to any Indian Airport.
- 5. Accordingly Ministry of Civil Aviation's Air Suvidha Portal has to be made operational for passengers in all international flights from these countries, with a provision to allow international travellers arriving in India to submit negative RT-PCR test reports as well as to submit self-declaration form on this portal.
- The existing practice of post-arrival random testing of 2% travellers (irrespective of port of departure) shall continue.
- This arrangement is in practice with effect from 10:00 AM on Sunday, 1st January, 2023.
