CIRCULAR

Inspectorate Dock Safety, Paradip vide their letter No.IDP/T/75/2023 dated 16.06.2023 (copy enclosed) have informed that the requirement of notification of dangerous goods (as categorised in Schedule-II) prior to shipment by shipper and prior to unloading by Master of vessel and their Agent to Employer of Dock workers, Safety Officer of Port Authority and Inspector Dock Safety with statement in writing identifying the goods & specifying nature of the danger which they can give rise to and specifying the categories as per Regulation No. 76 of Dock Workers (safety, health & welfare) Regulations, 1990.

Further, it may also be ensured that all necessary precautions to be taken considering nature of danger which they can give rise to, and dangerous goods shall be loaded, unloaded & handled under supervision of responsible person who is familiar with the risks & precaution to be taken. Also in case of doubt as to nature of risks or precautions to be taken, it is advised to obtain necessary safety instructions from Safety Officer appointed by employer of dock workers under these regulations and for requirement of compliance of regulations for handling dangerous goods under Dock Workers (safety, health & welfare) Regulations, 1990.

Sub: Notification of dangerous goods and precautions to be taken while handling dangerous goods – reg.

Sir,

With reference to subject matter, it is to bring to your notice regarding requirement of notification of dangerous goods (as categorised in Schedule-II) prior to shipment by shipper and prior to unloading by Master of vessel and their Agent to Employer of Dock workers, Safety officer of Port Authority and Inspector Dock Safety with statement in writing identifying the goods & specifying nature of the danger which they can give rise to and specifying the categories as per Regulation No. 76 of Dock Workers (safety, health & welfare) Regulations, 1990. In view of above, it is advised to do needful for necessary compliance.

Further, it is to ensure that all necessary precautions to be taken considering nature of danger which they can give rise to, and dangerous goods shall be loaded, unloaded & handled under supervision of responsible person who is familiar with the risks & precaution to be taken. Also in case of doubt as to nature of risks or precautions to be taken, it is advised to obtain necessary safety instructions from Safety officer appointed by employer of dock workers under these regulations and for requirement of compliance of regulations for handling dangerous goods under Dock Workers (Safety, Health & Welfare) Regulations, 1990.

In view of above you're hereby advised to do needful for necessary compliance and submit the action taken report to this Inspectorate within 10 days.

SCHEDULE II
CLASSIFICATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS
(See Regulation 76)

Class 1. Explosives.

Class 2. Gases: compressed, liquified and dissolved under pressure.

Class 3. Inflammable liquids.

Class 4.1 Inflammable solids.

Class 4.2 Inflammable solids, or substances, liable to spontaneous combustion.

Class 4.3 Inflammable solids, or substances, which in contact with water emit flammable gases.

Class 5.1 Oxidizing substances.

Class 5.2 Organic peroxides.

Class 6.1 Poisonous (toxic) substances.

Class 6.2 Infectious substances.

Class 7 Radioactive substances.

Class 8 Corrosives.

Class 9 Miscellaneous dangerous substances.

Dangerous substances belonging to class 9 above include any such substance which cannot be referred to any other class but which experience has shown to be so dangerous that these regulations shall apply to it.
