CIRCULAR

As the sea condition during South-west Monsoon seasons i.e. from May to October normally remains rough, hence, sign on / sign off of crew boarding & disembarking of Vetting Inspector & Superintendent, Surveyors attending to statutory Surveys at Paradip SPMs and Anchorages to be avoided during the above period.

However, in case of unavoidable circumstances subject to weather permitting, they may be allowed to board & disembark when the vessel is underway on submission of Indemnity Letter (as per enclosed format) signed by the Master of the vessel and the person boarding / disembarking.

This Circular will supersede all other circulars issued in this regard.
